

MIKE MULLEN & MIKE COEL MOTOR TO WINS AT OUTAGAMIE SPEEDWAY

(Seymour, WI) 5/20/18 Outagamie Speedway powered by EWSC Race Report- 129 total cars checked in to do battle for the first point night of the season at Outagamie Speedway. There were 32 IMCA Modified, 32 IMCA Stock Cars, 28 IMCA Sport Mods, 20 Street Stocks and 17 IMCA Sport Compacts.

Josh Long paced the IMCA Modified field until Mike Mullen took the top spot away on lap 8. Long's hope to regain the lead went up in smoke as his car broke and coasted to the infield. Mullen pulled away claiming the win with a clean sweep of the night. Benji LaCrosse had to settle for second, Brian Mullen was third, Jerry Wilinski took fourth and Kevin Feck completed the top five.

In IMCA Stock Car action it was Eric Arneson leading the field to the green. Arneson led the caution filled event until Mike Coel slipped by down low on lap 10 to secure the top spot. Coel withstood heavy pressure the remainder of the event but stood strong collecting the win. Arneson was second, Rod Snellenberger took third, Trent Nolan placed fourth and Larry Karcz rounded out the top five.

Chase Solomon took command of the Street Stock feature until lap 15 when his car coasted to the infield. This handed the lead over to Kevin Hebbe. Hebbe paced the next 4 circuits until Jordan Ross worked his way under Hebbe for the top spot. With the checkers waving Ross was able to steal the win. Hebbe had to settle for second, Corey Wegner was third, fourth went to Gary Kasperek and Lexii Ashcraft rounded out the top five.

Defending IMCA Sport Mod champion Travis Hanson dominated the Sport Mod feature, leading every lap en route to victory. Lucas Lambries was second, Robby Thiel placed third, Cody Schroeder took fourth and fifth went to Kyle Raddant.

DJ Jorgenson was victorious in the IMCA Sport Compacts.
