

## **MIKE MULLEN, LAMBRIES & VAN OOYEN VICTORIOUS AT OUTAGAMIE**

**(Seymour, WI) 7/8/18 Outagamie Speedway powered by EWSC Race Report:** A total of 112 cars checked in to do battle for point night number 4. There were 25 IMCA Modifieds, 28 IMCA Stock Cars, 28 IMCA Sport Mods, 16 Street Stocks and 16 IMCA Sport Compacts.

In IMCA Stock Car action Barry Streck used his outside starting spot to ride the cushion to the top spot. Defending champ Chas Van Ooyen worked the low groove and began to chase down Streck. With 10 to go Van Ooyen caught the leader and duo battled side by side with Van Ooyen taking over the top spot on lap 13. Van Ooyen led the rest of the way, earning a clean sweep of the night. Brandon Czarapata closed in late but had to settle for second place pay, Jeremy Christians was third, Eric Arneson placed fourth and Rod Snellenberger took fifth. Snellenberger now leads the point standings.

Eugene Gregorich Sr. looked to be the man to beat in the IMCA Sport Mods as he led from the drop of the green. Gregorich built a sizable advantage until point leader Lucas Lambries broke free of traffic and began to track down the leader. With 5 laps remaining Lambries caught Gregorich, applying heavy pressure down low. With 2 laps remaining Lambries made his move, slipping by Gregorich to take the win. Kyle Raddant was able to sneak by Gregorich to take second, Gregorich was third, RW Aschenbrenner placed fourth and Cody Schroeder rounded out the top five.

Brekken Kleinschmidt paced the opening laps of the IMCA Modified feature until Jerry Wilinski made the pass down low for the top spot on lap 12. Wilinski's reign upfront didn't last long as point leader Mike Mullen motored by on lap 14. Mullen pulled away from the pack to score his 2nd feature win of the season. Wilinski had to settle for second, Kleinschmidt had his best run of the season to place third, Tyler Wilson was fourth and Marcus Yarie completed the top five.

Jeff Richards went back to back in the Street Stocks. Richards passed Matt Warner for the lead on lap 8 and dominated the main event. Logan Lannet had a career best run to place second, Warner was third, Kevin Hebbe took fourth and Logan Schmeck placed fifth.

Ben Schulte led all 15 laps to score his first ever win in the IMCA Sport Compacts.
