

BRIAN MULLEN & KYLE FREDERICK FASTEST AT OUTAGAMIE SPEEDWAY

(Seymour, WI) 7/15/18 Race Report from Outagamie Speedway powered by EWSC. A grand total of 103 checked in to do battle Sunday night. Division car counts were; 27 IMCA Stock Cars, 23 IMCA Sport Mods, 20 IMCA Modifieds, 17 Sport Compacts and 16 Street Stocks.

An opening lap wreck in the IMCA Modified headliner sent point leader Mike Mullen down pit lane with damage, he would not return. JJ Andersen led from the drop of the green until lap 6 when Konnor Wilinski threw a slide job, muscling his way to the top spot. Wilinski paced the field running up top as Brian Mullen worked through the field. Mullen began to close on the back bumper of the leader with 5 to go. As the white flag flew, Mullen made his move diving under Wilinski. Mullen led the final lap to secure his first feature win of the season. With the win Mullen took over the points lead. Wilinski had to settle for second, Jerry Wilinski was third, fourth went to Marcus Yarie and Chad Bartel completed the top five.

Paul Holschuh led the first 5 laps of the IMCA Stock Car feature until Kyle Frederick raced by. Frederick was immediately dogged by Jeremy Christians for the lead. Christians took over the top spot working the low groove on lap 10. Frederick stayed true to the high side, pulling door to door with Christians over the next 6 laps. With 3 laps remaining Frederick gained upper hand, securing the top spot for good, taking home the win. Christians had to settle for second at the pay window, Chas Van Ooyen took third, Travis Van Straten placed fourth and Holschuh was fifth.

Cody Schroeder raced past Cole Mangin with 4 laps remaining to win the IMCA Sport Mod feature. Point leader Lucas Lambries placed second, Jayden Schmidt was third, Mangin took fourth and JR Hansen rounded out the top five.

Jeff Richards won his third feature in a row in the Street Stocks. Ryan Manthei was second, Wes Lungwitz had a career best run to place third, Lexii Ashcraft took fourth and Dylan Stedjee was fifth.

Michael Brehmer came out on top in the IMCA Sport Compact feature.
