

## **POINT SHAKE-UPS SHAPE THE LANDSCAPE AT OUTAGAMIE SPEEDWAY**

**(Seymour, WI) August 5, 2018 Race Report:** With only 2-point nights remaining several point leaders faltered at Outagamie Speedway Powered by EWSC Racing. A huge crash on the 2nd lap of the IMCA Stock Car feature saw Larry Karcz Jr barrel roll. Caught up in the carnage were co-point leaders Rod Snellenberger and Trent Nolan. All drivers were ok and returned to action, including Karcz. Snellenberger and Nolan encounter mechanical troubles midway through the contest and did not finish. Joe White paced the field early with Travis Van Straten hot on his heels. Lap 6 saw Van Straten take the lead, cruising the rest of the way to the feature win. Devin Snellenberger charged from 12<sup>th</sup> to place second. White was third. With a fourth-place finish Mike Coel took over the point lead. Chas Van Ooyen started 15<sup>th</sup> to finish fifth. Coel leads Snellenberger by 2 points and Nolan by 4.

Tyler Wilson took the lead away from Jamie Schmidt on the 2nd lap of the IMCA Modified main. Wilson built up a big lead but a caution on lap 9 erased that. The restart saw Jerry Wilinski whisk by for the top spot. Wilinski dominated the remaining 10 laps, scoring a clean sweep on the night. Point leader Marcus Yarie closed in late but ran out of laps. Rookies Wyatt Block and Hunter Parsons were next across the stripe and Konnor Wilinski was fifth. Yarie holds a commanding 30-point advantage over Parsons.

Ryan Plog appeared to be on his way to his first career feature in the IMCA Sport Mods, leading the first 14 laps of the main. Several cautions were the demise of Plogs' bid for the win, allowing point leader Lucas Lambries to work his way to the front. Lambries was the class of the field, taking over with 6 laps remaining to score another win. Plog had nothing to hang his head about with his best run of his career. Defending champ Travis Hansen was third and trailed by JR Hansen and Cody Schroeder. Schroeder trails Lambries by 18 marks.

Defending Street Stock champion Paul Ambrosius scored a clean sweep. Jordan Ross came into the night leading the Street Stock points but mechanical issues ended his night early. Ambrosius survived vicious a late race challenge from Matt Warner to score his first trophy of the season. Kevin Hebbe was third, Jeff Richards and Lexii Ashcraft completed the top five. Hebbe leads Ross and Ashcraft by 6 spots.

Michael Brehmer passed TJ Everard on the final lap of the IMCA Sport Compact feature to earn his second win of the season. Al Cottrell had his engine expire, handing the point lead to Everard. Everard leads by just 4 points.

Our next night of racing is on Friday August 10 for the Dirt Kings Late Model Tour. IMCA Modifieds, IMCA Stock Cars, IMCA Sport Mods, Street Stocks and IMCA Sport Compacts will be in action. Hot Laps at 6:00pm with racing to begin at 6:30pm. This is a non-track point night. State and National points will be awarded.
